The following documents and supporting information are required by the Bureau of Fee-For-Service Programs to enroll as a provider: ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE LEGIBLE TO BE ACCEPTED.

- Provider Enrollment Application with signed provider agreement
- Copy of SSN or W-2. **Note: W-9s are NOT accepted.**
- If the Social Security card states “Valid for work only with INS authorization”, please submit a copy of the paperwork generated by the INS or Department of Homeland Security that shows proof of authorization to work in the United States
- Copy of Physician License
- Copy of DEA Certificate
- Copy of the **NPPES Confirmation letter** showing the NPI Number and Taxonomy(s) assigned to the individual applying for enrollment
- For Specialty 558, include the Service Description denoting approval by the Bureau of Children’s Behavioral Health Services, Office of Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS). Contact the Bureau at RA-BHRS@pa.gov or 717-705-8289 for additional information or requirements
- Copy of Board Certification, if applicable
- Copy of Mammography Certificate, if applicable
- Copy of your PA Clinical Laboratory Permit and CLIA Certificate, if applicant performs laboratory services
- Proof of home state Medicaid participation (out of state providers)
